
Our investigation indicates that 75% of the beneficiary group of the Oliver's House programs are natural persons who are Black.

In terms of clause 3.2 of Code 700 of the Codes of Good Practice, the **full value of contributions** made by entities to Oliver's House may be included as Socio-economic Development contributions by such entities.

In terms of clause 5 of Statement 004 of Code 000 of the Codes of Good Practice, the status of contributions made to Oliver's House is not dependent on Oliver's House's scorecard result, but rather on the nature of the contribution itself and the identity of the beneficiaries.

This assessment was compiled and validated in terms of the Codes of Good Practice of the Broad-based Black Economic Empowerment Act, published on 9 February 2007.

Vision xQ Consulting cc (which operates under the governing conditions and ethics of the *Institute for Independent Business*) is not an accredited verification agency. Vision xQ will, however, be able to provide and independently endorse the assessment for Oliver's House as factual at any time.
